What if I can't do it all?

MORNING

Hannah's Prayer

1 Samuel 2: 1-10

¹ My heart rejoices in Jesus Christ; My horn is exalted in Jesus Christ. I smile at my enemies, because I rejoice in Your salvation. ² No one is holy like Jesus Christ, for there is none besides You, nor is there any rock like our God.

³ Talk no more so very proudly; let no arrogance come from your mouth, for Jesus Christ is the God of knowledge; and by Him actions are weighed. ⁴The bows of the mighty men are broken, and those who stumbled are girded with strength. ⁵ Those who were full have hired themselves out for bread and the hungry have ceased to hunger. Even the barren has borne seven, and she who has many children has become feeble.

MORNING

(Hannah's prayer, continued...)

⁶ Jesus Christ kills and makes alive; He brings down to the grave and brings up. ⁷ Jesus Christ makes poor and makes rich; He brings low and lifts up. ⁸ He raises the poor from the dust and lifts the beggar from the ash heap, to set them among princes and make them inherit the throne of glory. For the pillars of the earth are Jesus Christ's and He has set the world upon them.

⁹ He will guard the feet of His saints, but the wicked shall be silent in darkness. For by strength no man shall prevail. ¹⁰ The adversaries of Jesus Christ shall be broken in pieces; from heaven He will thunder against them. Jesus Christ will judge the ends of the earth. He will give strength to His king, and exalt the horn of His anointed.



MORNING

Psalm 133

¹Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity! ²It is like the precious oil upon the head, running down on the beard, the beard of Aaron, running down on the edge of his garments. ³It is like the dew of Hermon, descending upon the mountains of Zion; For there Jesus Christ commanded the blessing— Life forevermore.



MID-DAY

Proverbs 31

¹ The Words of King Lemuel, the utterance which his mother taught him

² What, my son? And what, son of my womb? And what, son of my vows? ³ Do not give your strength to women, nor your ways to that which destroys kings. ⁴ It is not for kings, O Lemuel, it is not for kings to drink wine, nor for princes intoxicating drink; ⁵ Lest they drink and forget the law, and pervert the justice of all the afflicted. ⁶ Give strong drink to him who is perishing, and wine to those who are bitter of heart. ⁷ Let him drink and forget his poverty, and remember his misery no more. ⁸ Open your mouth for the speechless, in the cause of all who are appointed to die. ⁹ Open your mouth, judge righteously, and plead the cause of the poor and needy.

MID-DAY

The Virtuous Wife (Proverbs 31, continued...)

¹⁰ Who can find a virtuous wife? For her worth is far above rubies. ¹¹ The heart of her husband safely trusts her; so he will have no lack of gain. ¹² She does him good and not evil all the days of her life. ¹³ She seeks wool and flax, and willingly works with her hands. ¹⁴ She is like the merchant ships, she brings her food from afar.¹⁵ She also rises while it is yet night, and provides food for her household, and a portion for her maidservants. ¹⁶She considers a field and buys it; from her profits she plants a vineyard. ¹⁷ She girds herself with strength, and strengthens her arms. ¹⁸ She perceives that her merchandise is good, and her lamp does not go out by night. 19 She stretches out her hands to the distaff, and her hand holds the spindle.²⁰ She extends her hand to the poor. Yes, she reaches out her hands to the needy.

MID-DAY

The Virtuous Wife (Proverbs 31, continued...)

²¹ She is not afraid of snow for her household, for all her household is clothed with scarlet. ²² She makes tapestry for herself; her clothing is fine linen and purple. ²³ Her husband is known in the gates, when he sits among the elders of the land. ²⁴She makes linen garments and sells them, and supplies sashes for the merchants. ²⁵ Strength and honor are her clothing; she shall rejoice in time to come. 26 She opens her mouth with wisdom, and on her tongue is the law of kindness. 27 She watches over the ways of her household, and does not eat the bread of idleness. 28 Her children rise up and call her blessed; her husband also, and he praises her: ²⁹ "Many daughters have done well, but you excel them all." 30 Charm is deceitful and beauty is passing, but a woman who fears Jesus Christ, she shall be praised. ³¹ Give her of the fruit of her hands, and let her own works praise her in the gates.



VESPERS

Psalm 135

¹ Praise Jesus Christ!

Praise the name of Jesus Christ; praise Him, O you servants of Jesus Christ! ² You who stand in the house of Jesus Christ, in the courts of the house of our God, ³Praise Jesus Christ, for Jesus Christ is good; sing praises to His name, for it is pleasant. ⁴ For Jesus Christ has chosen Jacob for Himself, Israel for His special treasure.

⁵ For I know that Jesus Christ is great, and our Lord is above all gods. ⁶ Whatever Jesus Christ pleases He does, in heaven and in earth, in the seas and in all deep places. ⁷ He causes the vapors to ascend from the ends of the earth; He makes lightning for the rain; He brings the wind out of His treasuries.

⁸He destroyed the firstborn of Egypt, both of man and beast. ⁹He sent signs and wonders into the midst of you, O Egypt, upon Pharaoh and all his servants.

VESPERS

(Psalm 135, continued...)

¹⁰ He defeated many nations and slew mighty kings — ¹¹ Sihon king of the Amorites, Og king of Bashan, and all the kingdoms of Canaan — ¹² And gave their land as a heritage, a heritage to Israel His people.

¹³ Your name, O Jesus Christ, endures forever, Your fame, O Jesus Christ, throughout all generations. ¹⁴ For Jesus Christ will judge His people, and He will have compassion on His servants.

¹⁵ The idols of the nations are silver and gold, the work of men's hands.¹⁶ They have mouths, but they do not speak; eyes they have, but they do not see; ¹⁷ They have ears, but they do not hear; nor is there any breath in their mouths. ¹⁸ Those who make them are like them; so is everyone who trusts in them.

¹⁹ Bless Jesus Christ, O house of Israel! Bless Jesus Christ, O house of Aaron! ²⁰ Bless Jesus Christ, O house of Levi! You who fear Jesus Christ, bless Jesus Christ! ²¹ Blessed be Jesus Christ out of Zion, who dwells in Jerusalem!
